Wycombe Sharing of Faith's first pilgrimage in Wycombe Sunday 20 November 11

As we proceed from Brook Street to Jubilee Road we will be walking on pavements and covering only a short distance. At each stopping place we will meet a group of followers of a different faith – Sikh, Baha'i, Christian and Muslim—and ask them how they engage with their children and young people, how they nurture them in faith and spiritual life.

Bring a head covering with you so that you can be respectful of the customs in the gurdwara and mosque.

- 1.20 Gather outside the Gurdwara, Brook Street, High Wycombe HP11 2EQ
 If it is raining there is cover available.
- 1.30 - 2.00 Presentation at the Sikh Gurdwara
 Men and women will need to remove shoes and cover their head.
 The gurdwara usually has a supply of handkerchief-like squares suitable for men
- 2.05 - 2.35 Visit Baha'is at the Step-In Community Café, Desborough Road
- 2.45 - 3.15 Visit Oakridge Road Baptist Church HP11 2PH
- 3.15 Cup of tea at Jubilee Road mosque HP11 2PJ
3.30 - 4.00 Presentation etc at the mosque
 Everyone needs to remove shoes; women should cover their head
- 4.07 OPTIONAL observe Maghrib prayer in the mosque

If you can't join right at the start, join us along the way. If you have to leave before the end, feel free to do so. If you belong to a place of worship invite them to walk with us for friendship sake, and tell your friends and neighbours too.

We look forward to sharing the journey with you.
